Qualifications

- b) Possession of registration as Medical doctor from Zanzibar/Tanzania Medical Council.
- (c) Working experience of at least three (3) years in medicine.
- (d) Good Command of English and Kiswahili languages. An understanding of Arabic language will be an added advantage.
