**UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR MUSLIM**  
**COMMUNITIES IN NON-MEMBER COUNTRIES**  
**ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19**



1. The Islamic Development Bank (IsDB), a Multilateral Development Organization, is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships for Muslim Communities in Non-Member Countries to pursue undergraduate studies, in their own country or in one of the IsDB Member Countries. The fields of study should be in development-related disciplines in line with the IsDB President's new strategy to empower communities with a special focus on sustainability science to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
2. The scholarship is a grant to eligible students. After graduation and employment, students must undertake to cover:
  - a. Either the fees of the first year's study for a new undergraduate student,
  - b. Or the fees of the first year of his/her Master's degree. In this case, the IsDB will support him/her by covering the fees to complete his/her Master's degree.
3. Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - Have completed high school certificate with good grades in major subjects and language of instruction.
  - Have secured admission or are already enrolled in a recognized University in their home country. Consideration may be given to some students to study in one of the IsDB Member Countries.
  - Are not currently in receipt of any other scholarship.
  - Are committed to serve their community after graduation.
  - Accept the scholarship program conditions and sign the IsDB Bond.
4. Selected applicants will pursue their undergraduate studies in any of the following major fields of study:
